FINANCIAL

Discounted electricity via lease of roof space for solar array

Our not-for-profit community benefit society will lease your roof space to house a solar array for 20 years. The clean energy generated will be supplied to the building owner at a discounted rate. Solar panels can also be installed on under-utilised brownfield land.

Direct investment

The council may choose to invest directly in the Energy Garden community benefit society and receive a reliable annual return of approximately 4%.

SOCIAL

Training and mentoring

By providing training and mentoring opportunities for local people as part of the Energy Garden internship programme, the council will support community and employment skills development, creating positive social outcomes.

Health and well-being

From community gardening of fruits and vegetables and an improved station environment to interactive displays explaining the benefits of healthy living, Energy Garden will contribute to improved health and wellbeing of people living in your Borough.

ENVIRONMENTAL

Energy Garden will contribute to environmental targets by generating clean energy, creating green spaces and ecologically rich areas in the heart of your Borough.
